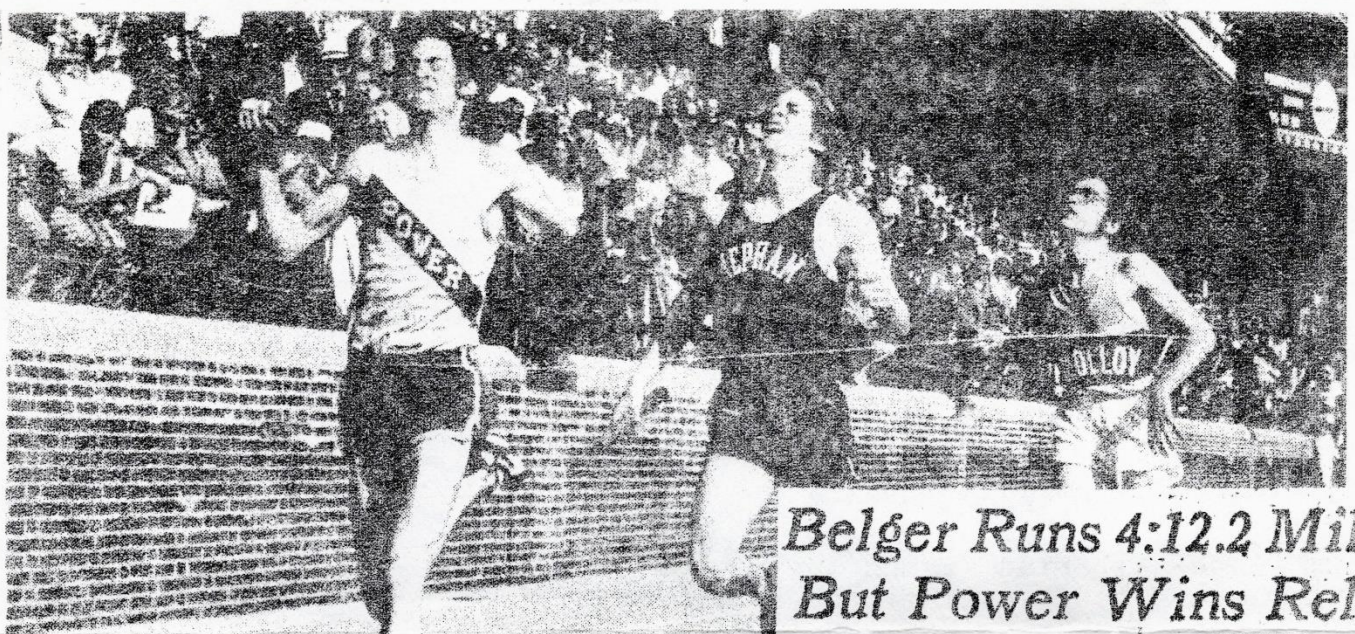

Belger Runs 4:12.2 Mile, But Power Wins Relay

PHILADELPHIA, April 26 —Mark Belger brought the Franklin Field crowd to its feet today with a tremendous effort on the anchor leg of the schoolboy distance medley relay.

But with practically every-one rooting him home, the talented Mepham (L. I.) High Senior lost out to Brian Johnston of Power Memorial by two feet in one of the most exciting medley finishes ever run at the Penn Relays.

Power's winning time of 10 minutes 16.8 seconds was not fast considering the ideal weather conditions and the good Tartan track. But the race made up for it. Belger, touched off seventh, some 70 yards behind the leading runner, raced through the first 440 in a blazing 58.2 seconds. He was fifth at the 880 post
