## THE 1936 TRACK TEAM

THE first attempt to organize a school track team was made in the Spring of 1936. Under the guiding hand of Rev. Br. Lannon it proved eminently successful. He discovered among the students several promising athletes. These he developed by careful training and they had the satisfaction of defeating the teams of other schools. By the small margin of two points these Power boys defeated Iona, the score being 62-60.

Soon afterwards they met the representatives of Regis High in a dual meet. The result was by no means disappointing even though they had to concede victory to their rivals.

Subsequently they accepted the invitation to participate in the municipal Catholic High Schools meet at Manhattan College. Here our midget and junior divisions succeeded in capturing no fewer than nine trophies. Although the seniors were not quite so fortunate they, too, made a good showing and helped to set the standard for future track teams of the Power Memorial Academy.

At the time of going to press the 1937 squad is hard at practice preparing for a formidable schedule arranged for the approaching season.
