Jackson, now a Purdue freshman, ranked as the second swiftest half-miler in the country with a 1:50.8 effort and established a new state record for the mile with a time of 4:09.1n.

Westchester's MT. VERNON High easily mates as the state's top team for 1967. The Dave Rider-coached athletes displayed depth in virtually all events, ranked several athletes on the listings, and won an assortment of titles while competing in both dual and major meets. Their star hurdlers--Joe Kurzrok and Bob Daniels--competed in the Golden West Invitational with Kurzrok winning the 330-yard intermediates in the national record clocking of 37.3.

Foreword

Last Year's first annual edition of New York State Scholastic Track marked a major breakthrough in high school record compilation for performances registered by athletes in this state. This year's edition marks an even greater breakthrough.

For the first time all-time listings, indoors and outdoors, have been compiled. These listings boast the top 50 performers, outdoors, and the top 20, indoors, regardless of the year in which they accomplished their feats. Also included for the first time are class marks (national and state)--the leading performances (outdoors) made by athletes while competing as freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors.

Other sections of this anthology of local, prepsters deal with leading performers, 20 deep outdoors and 10 deep indoors for 1967; and national, state and league records both on the boards and around the cinders.

In the 1967 groupings, I have included all qualifying marks made between September 1, 1966 and August 31, 1967. This rule also applies to records and the classification of athletes into grades. Such athletes are considered to be juniors, for example, until the September 1 prior to their senior year. Furthermore, for purposes of maximum completeness, no performances have been restricted because of type of meet, form of competition, or placing in an event.

I am complying with the international rule which rounds off all marks recorded in races of more than one mile to the nearest fifth without going under the actual clocking.

On the listings the athlete's school follows his name with the location next. If there is no location listed, then the names of both the school and location are identical.

"B" teams on relay lists refer to a second set of runners from the same school whose performance--as the same race as the first team competed in--qualified them for the

list.

Virtually all statistical projects require consultation with various informed sources. This publication is no exception.

During the past year I have consulted scores of coaches, officials, athletes, reporters and just plain "track nuts." It would be impractical to acknowledge all of these contributions, but some major credits must be noted. Special thanks go to Hugh Gardner (Track & Field News), track nuts Lee Smith (Gasport, N.Y.), Don MacArthur (New Rochelle, N.Y.) and Jim Spier (Massapequa, N.Y.), and coaches John Covert (formerly of Ossining, now at Lehigh U.), Ed Kehe (White Plains), Joe Schatzle (Wappingers), Milt Blatt (Jackson), Doug Terry (Boys) and Frank Rienzo (Molloy).

It would be naive for me to contend that this publication is without error. The only way that any errors can be corrected is for you--the informed track public---to notify me of them. Information regarding additions and corrections would be greatly appreciated.
