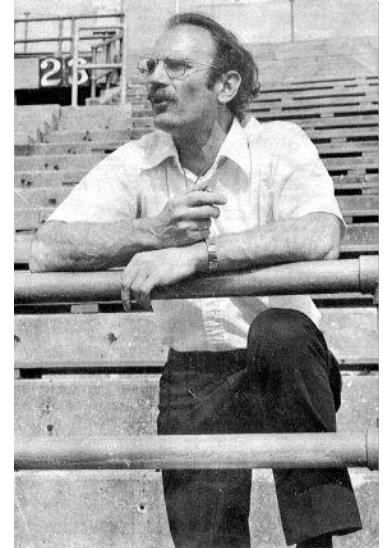

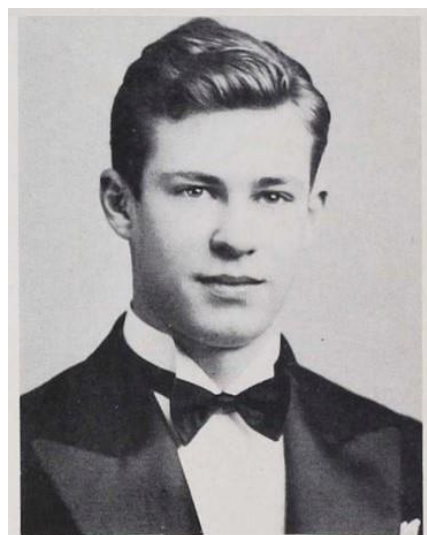

Fikes Wins 3d C.H.S.A.A. Cross-Country Title

Denis Fikes of Rice ended an era at Van Cortlandt Park yesterday by capturing his third straight Catholic High Schools Athletic Association cross-country title.

The undefeated 18-year-old senior concluded the fall season with his sixth victory and his 16th in 20 outings over a three-year period. His clocking of 12 minutes 25.7 seconds was a personal low that shattered his own meet and New York State records, but fell short of the course mark of 12:23.2, set in 1966 by Marty Liguori of Essex Catholic.

Power Memorial of Manhattan won its fourth team championship in the last five years.

The Panthers, led by Tom Colon, who was second, tallied 84 points in the 44-school meet.

Fikes greeted the crisp winter chill by taking a slim lead into the hills on the 2½-mile Bronx course and gradually lengthened his margin. "I don't know by how much because I never looked back," Fikes said.

Colon followed Fikes through the winding trails, but never got within striking distance. Fikes entered the final straightaway with a huge lead and responded to encouragement from the crowd by giving it all he had for a 120-yard victory. Colon's time was 12:49.

Fikes thus ended a season that was marked by six

straight clockings under 13 minutes on the tough course.

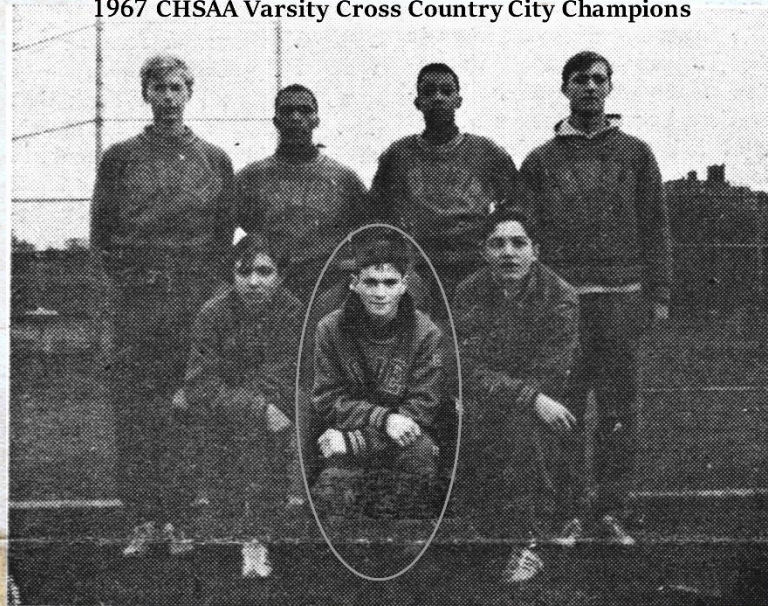

Protopappas Triumphs in 12:51 In C.H.S.A.A. Cross-Country

Fred Protopappas of Nazareth ran the fastest schoolboy cross-country race at Van Cortlandt Park this season yesterday while winning the Catholic High School Athletic Association championship.

Protopappas covered the 2½-mile course in 12 minutes 51 seconds to set a meet record. Power Memorial easily won the team title with 56 points.

The 17-year-old senior's time clipped a full second off the mark set in last year's meet by Kevin O'Brien. O'Brien, then a senior at Power Memorial, is now a freshman at Notre Dame.

Protopappas also broke 13 minutes last Saturday when his 12:57 clocking gave him second place to Eamon Downey in the Brooklyn sectional championships. This time Downey was the runner-up, about 55 yards back at the finish.

Protopappas was among the first six at the beginning of the grind. He followed Downey and Edward Walsh of Molloy into the hills and kept in third position until the straightaway a half-mile from the finish.

He then unleashed a kick that enabled him to pass both Downey and Walsh, who finished third in 13:09. It was the second triumph of the season for Protopappas. He won the Brooklyn borough championships earlier in the season in 13:19.

The winning Power Memorial team had its five harriers finish among the first 20. Garth McKay was the first Power runner and finished seventh in 13:28. Mario Campo was eighth in 13:29; Richard Stewart ninth in 13:35; Chancy Marsh 12th in 13:42 and Albert Novell 20th in 13:49.

The long days of practice have finally paid off for the track team. On Saturday, October 30, at Van Cortlandt Park, the annual CHSAA Championships (Sectionals) were held and Power Memorial reigned victorious. The superior individual performances of the Varsity, Junior Varsity, and the Freshmen contingents brought first place honors to each group and all three championship plaques back to school. While making up 53 points the Varsity beat 19 schools from Manhattan, the Bronx, and Westchester. The J.V. won with a surprising high of 48.

The Varsity club was led by Senior Kevin O'Brien who took 1st out of 278 runners and covered the 2½ mile course in 13 minutes and 17 seconds. He was followed by Richard Stewart, a Sophomore, who placed a resounding 3rd. Walter Walsh, Garth McKay, Kerry O'Brien, Phil Kenney, and Mario Campo placed in the top 25. The J.V. squad was led by Junior Bob Spaulding who ran 14 minutes and 20 seconds and took 1st place. Second place went to Richard Rios, 3rd to Walter Gore, 4th to Riordon, 5th to O'Hanlon, 6th to Ivan Quervalu, and 7th to Harold Holmes. Having the first 7 men to finish out of 280 from one school, shook the league as an unprecedented win. Other places were Majernik 11th, Wakefield Mahon 16th, and Irvin 18th.

The other squads put the seed of fear into the Catholic School League by placing 4th, 9th and 13th in the same track race as the Junior Varsity.
