

It's Gerry, Paul, Jim

It has been suggested that man may be reaching the leveling off point regarding the ultimate in times, heights and distances in track and field.

This may very well be true at the top level, but certainly not in the high school ranks whose representatives may soon go to the head of the class just as the swimmers have done through the vigorous age group program in this country.

Certainly the 1964 season would refute such beliefs--if they really do exist. The '64 campaign will be remembered as the year three super-stars smashed three major barriers and when two of those three represented Uncle Sam in the Olympic Games in Tokyo.

Many others accounted for national, all-time, age and class standards and there was even more depth than the previous year which was featured by the great number of top level performers.

Gerry Lindgren, Jim Ryun and Paul Wilson were the super stars of 1964 and whose performances will be reviewed here before they are forgotten by the 1965 crop which is anxious to get a new season underway. Ryun and Wilson will be among those contending for the headlines.

Lindgren, tiny (5'6" and 120-lbs.) competitor from Rogers in Spokane, Washington, started his antics during the indoor season a year ago. He ran 9:00 in a prep race in his indoor debut in San Francisco. On the same boards a month later, he clocked 8:40 for the two mile in a field which included Australia's Ron Clarke. He wound up his season in October--in Tokyo where he wore Uncle Sam's Stars & Stripes in the Olympic Games 10,000 meter run.

Lindgren ran 8:56.5 outdoors and his 4:06 in his state meet is the national prep record for the mile run.

Ryun rocked the world when he became the first prep in history to run a sub-four minute mile. He literally crushed the all-time prep mark with his fantastic 3:59.0 in the Compton Invitational--and he too wound up his season as a member of the U.S. Olympic Team in Tokyo where he reached the semi-finals in the 1500-meter run. Ryun is currently in his senior year at Wichita East in Wichita, Kansas.

The third super-star and barrier breaker was Paul Wilson who didn't stop at 15-feet in the pole vault--he went all the way up to 16'0" and made the 15'0" vaults ordinary occurrences. He too is currently in his senior year at Warren High School in Downey, California.

Nine athletes smashed seven individual national prep records in regularly contested events and five competitors tied three others during the course of a fantastic campaign. This does not include three more who set all-time prep records but whose efforts have not been recognized as high school standards because they were registered in non-high school meets.

Four relay marks also fell by the wayside and one more was tied.

In addition to standards in the regular high school events, Lindgren accounted for prep bests at three miles (13:17), 5000-meters (13:44), six miles (28:23.7) and 10,000-meters (29:17.6).

Ryun also accounted for an all-time best--his amazing 3:39.0 1500 meters.

Another whose efforts would be classed in the super-star category in a normal year would be Earl McCullouch of Poly High in Long Beach, Calif. He clocked 13.7 and 18.1 in the hurdles. McCullouch shares interscholastic marks with two others in each event, but he won all 50 hurdle races in which he took part and his victims included those with whom he shares the marks.

A number of others could be placed in the super category. 

An idea of the depth of talent produced by the high schools can best be described by the performance which ranks as the 20th best in each event: 100 (9.6); 220 (straight course) 21.1; 440 (48.2); 880 (1:53.4); Mile (4:16.3); Two-Mile (9:29.7); 120 HH (14.1); 180 LH (19.0); HJ (6'6¾"); PV (14'5"); LJ (23'8¼"); SP (60'2¼"); DT (175'3"); JT (205'6"); TJ (45'7¾").

One would not have to go back many years when all, or all but a few

of those efforts, would have rated as the best in the nation.

And one need not think all the talent has left the high schools. Indeed not as the returnees make prospects for the 1965 campaign the best in all prep annals.

A glance at our "Athletes-of-the-Year" by classes and in separate track and field categories may offer the best assurance that the best is yet to come.

SENIOR (Track) Lindgren, 8:40 indoor mark and 4:01.5 during summer meet in Jamaica plus his fabulous performances in Olympic events qualify him as top senior runner. (Field) Elwyn Bethea of Central in Trenton, NJ. 66'4¼" in shot put and 185'8½" in discus makes him top senior field athlete. Takes place alongside Dallas Long and Randy Matson among all-time great prep weightmen.

JUNIOR (Track) Jim Ryun, and who will argue. First prep to run sub-four minute mile (3:59.0) and made U.S. Olympic team in 1500-meter run. Also ran 1:50.3n in 880. (Field) Paul Wilson, and there should be no argument here either. First prep over 16'. With Ryun, makes up greatest junior twosome in all track annals.

SOPHOMORE (Track) Mike Owens, Valencia of Placentia, Calif. Always at his best in big meets and improved times with each succeeding meet. Just missed a spot in state finals with his sophomore class mark of 1:53.4n. (Field) Picked two great ones here--Johnny Johnson of Pacific Grove, Calif, and Bill McClellon of DeWitt Clinton in New York City. Johnson long jumped 25'2¼" 25'2¼" in his Section finals. Also 9.7 and 21.3 in sprints. McClellon high jumped incredible 6'8½".

FROSH (Track) George Carty of Perth Amboy, NJ. Ran 14.0 in high hurdles and 19.1 for lows and had good competitive record in state which produces top quality hurdlers. Unfortunately, Carty will not run in 1965 because of New Jersey's rule against allowing competition for those who have reached their 19th birthday before the first day of school. (Field) Clifford (Chip) Kell, Murphy High School of Atlanta, Geo. This also is an easy selection. He waived prep shot 59'1". He's only 15, stands 6'1" and weighs 225 pounds.

1964 OLYMPIC FILM

Two movies of the 1964 Olympic Games are available for rental by groups, schools, or individuals. Reservations are being accepted for showings of one day or a week.

You have your choice of two fine films. One will be primarily for entertainment, the other for instruction. The entertainment film will have sound and color and will run 45 to 50 minutes. Rental is \$50 for one showing or \$125 for a full week. The instructional film will be silent, with titles, black and white, run for 60 to 75 minutes, and will rent for \$35 for one day, \$90 for one week. Both will feature most of the action in the men's track and field events at Tokyo and the entertainment film will show something of other sports and of Tokyo. The instructional film will emphasize tremendous slow motion photography by the official IAAF photographer, as slow as 110 to 140 frames per second.

For advance reservations indicate entertainment or instructional and list three dates. Official purchase orders are required from schools, full payment in advance from others. Reservation priority will be given to official purchase orders or cash payments, in order of receipt. Others may request dates with purchase order or payment upon confirmation.






